Dear Valued Customer,

The Dodd-Frank Act, Section 1502 (Conflict Minerals Act) Concerning Conflict Minerals requires disclosure of the mining source of the following materials: Gold, Tin, Tantalum and Tungsten.

Mid-West Spring and Stamping is not an issuer whose shares are publicly traded in the United States and, therefore, is not directly subject to the Conflict Minerals Act.

Mid-West Spring and Stamping is not a manufacturer of spring steels or other materials used to manufacture mechanical springs. Mid-West Spring and Stamping Manufactures springs using material purchased from various spring steel suppliers. Tin (Sn) is used to manufacture bronze and bronze alloys used in the spring making industry. Mid-West Spring and Stamping has contacted all current vendors who are suppliers of bronze alloy material used for making springs and stampings at our facilities. Each vendor has submitted a disclosure statement showing that no materials are purchased from the regions know to be "Conflict Regions". Therefore, to the best of our knowledge, all of the materials purchased by Mid-West Spring that are used to manufacture our products have DRC-Conflict Free status.
